New OPT Reporting Tool

What is the OPT Reporting Tool?

The OPT Reporting Tool has been designed to save hours of headteachers' time by automatically extracting key summary data from the standard OPT resources in Integris or SIMS. Ofsted-required attainment data is compiled in the click of a button into easy-to-read tables.

How does it work?

Within SIMS and Integris, the OPT resources offer an extensive set of tools to record, analyse and extract key assessment data relating to the new National Curriculum. The recently released OPT reporting tool has been designed to automatically extract key summary data from the standard* OPT resources in Integris or SIMS.

For many years schools have effectively used OPT for recording individual pupil data and used the functionality within Integris or SIMS to analyse the data by groups. The new reporting tool will automatically generate, within a couple of minutes, key summary reports for years 1 to 6 in Reading, Writing, Maths and SPaG. This release includes reports on;

- Percentage & Average attainment
- Percentage & Average Progress
- KS1 & KS2 Progress
- Whole School Pupil Premium
- Whole School SEN
- Whole School Average Attainment, Average Progress, Steps of Progress
- Whole School On-Track for Expected including RWM Combined

*The reporting tool relies on schools using the standard OPT resources within SIMS or Integris. If your school is using bespoke assessment resources it is usually possible to map the data onto the OPT resources so that the reporting tool can be used. 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Many of the reports summarise the information by key groups including Gender, SEN, PP, FSM, Ever FSM, Service Child, Looked After, EAL, Ethnicity, Prior Attainment and Term of Birth. The reports can be saved and formatting (including headings) can be edited to suit individual schools, they can also be pasted into other documents.
